## Simeone Auto Museum

6825 Norwitch Drive, Philadelphia, PA, 19153 215/365-7233

Delaware Valley Section will gather at the renowned Simeone Automotive Foundation Museum at 10AM, to view 60 - 70 cars from historic international races. The museum offers a wide variety of cars which range from a sexy 1909 American Underslung, to a 21st century NASCAR racecar. The display includes cars from Italy's famous 1,000 mile Mille Miglia endurance race, as well as a number of historic winners of LeMans, which are displayed in a diorama setting. Don't dilly-dally around inside the museum too long, as "Driving Demonstration Days" begins at Noon (sharp), when Simeone takes several cars out of the museum for public demonstration. The featured cars will include a 1955 Mercedes-Benz 300SL Gullwing, Alpha Romeo Monza, Jaguar D-Type, Ferrari 3-seater, and an Austin Healey. 150+ spectators will be ogling the artwork on wheels up close and personal during a demonstration of the operation of each vehicle on Simeone's 3-acre lot. Upon conclusion, we will depart for an optional late lunch at Popi's (Italian) Restaurant ... about 2 miles away (free, on-site parking). Check out Popi's menu at PopisRestaurant.com.

## **American Endurance Racing: August 1 - 3**

Most have heard of Watkins Glen, Daytona or Laguna Seca road course racetracks. With the cost of some race cars exceeding \$500,000+, few have ever experienced the thrill. That's about to change. The *German Endurance of Mercedes-Benz* meets American Endurance Racing (AER), which brings the likes of vehicles such as BMW, Audi, Porsche, and a 1987 Mercedes-Benz 300E, the latter driven by Delaware Valley Section member John Peruto (brother of Jim Peruto, principal owner of Keenan Mercedes). Endurance racing is a form of Motorsports racing which tests the durability of equipment along with its drivers and mechanics. Teams of multiple drivers attempt to cover a large distance in a single event, with a change of drivers occurring during the race.

Though dozens of vehicles will hit the 2-mile track at New Jersey Motorsports Park (NJMP) in Millville, not all will survive the 18-hour endurance race which is held over a three days, in six hour increments. Unlike most televised auto races, most cars generally appear stock in nature, though they will sport a roll-cage, shed their glass and interiors, and have received various safety improvements to braking systems and the like. John's 1987 300E is similar to most other W124 sedans, in that it has over 225,000 miles on the odometer (well, the interior has been removed, so there is no odometer, no speedometer, no power windows, no rear seats ... you get the idea).

Cars race at breakneck speeds for much of the race, while the laws of physics take their toll at a steady attrition rate. Endurance racing packs all of the excitement of shorter races, but adds the drama of catastrophic mechanical breakdowns. Mercedes-Benz engineers their vehicles against the rigors of demanding drivers, while designing cars to last 20+ years of daily driving. John tests the endurance of a 25+ year old Mercedes-Benz in hourly increments; expecting the vintage German engineering in his 300E to complete the venue.

Spectators at NJMP are able to watch portions of the race from just behind a safety fence, or perched atop grandstands. Please join John, as he invites fellow MBCA members (wearing long pants and closed-toe shoes) to watch the race from the pit stall of his #300, where you will also witness pit stops up close and personal. NJMP is located at 8000 Dividing Creek Rd, Millville, NJ, 08332 (near Vineland). Contact NJMP at 856/327-8000 for ticket information and hours of operation. Please bring a lawn chair and cooler with beverages and lunch, if desired.

## Mid-Atlantic Regional Autocross: August 17

MBCA Keystone Section and Delaware Valley Section will host the Mid-Atlantic Regional Autocross, which will be held at Eurofins / Lancaster Labs, 2430 New Holland Pike, Lancaster, PA. The event will commence with a defensive driving clinic starting at 9AM, followed by the Autocross. MBCA Great Lakes Regional Director Frank Cozza and his wife Mary Alice will be assisting with the events.

An autocross consists of a course defined by orange pylons on a parking lot. The location of our Autocross is a large, smooth, flat, blacktop parking lot ... free of any landscape islands and light poles. The goal is to navigate your Mercedes-Benz through the course in the quickest time (though it is not a high speed event). You will learn about the braking and handling characteristic of your Mercedes. The skills you learn will help to make you a better and safer driver. All cars must undergo a short safety inspection on-site. Please remove all floor mats and loose objects from your car. Helmets which meet SNELL 2005 or newer rating (such as SNELL 2010) are required. Loaner helmets MAY be available. You may consider purchasing a new helmet, available at most motorcycle retailers for under \$100.

This is a Mercedes-Benz only event. Trophies will be presented for each class. The cost is only \$25 per driver and \$10 for guests / spectators (includes lunch).

## **IMPROMPTU - Indoor Go-Karting: September 6**

Members looking for a unique twist on car club activities will want to pay close attention to IMPROMPTU events, which require little or no advanced registration or reservation. Most impromptu events will be local, family friendly events. Our first impromptu event brings us to SPEED Raceway, Horsham, PA.

Bring the family for some indoor, four-wheelin' fun at the largest and fastest indoor karting facility in the USA! Two indoor race-tracks are housed within 100,000 square feet of air conditioned space, complete with a video arcade, drivers lounge, and public viewing area. Delaware Valley Section will also benefit from the use of a private meeting room with a floor-to-glass wall, which provides a perfect view of the action. The meeting room provides ample space with tables and chairs, televisions and leather sofas.

Karts are available for Junior drivers 48" and taller, age 6 - 11. Adult racing is available for those who are 56" and taller, age 12+. Juniors race on a track by themselves - no adults will be permitted to race on a track with juniors. FOR SAFETY REASONS, all long hair **must** be pulled back in a pony tail, and all drivers **must** wear closed-toe shoes. Clean, full face helmets are provided. Delaware Valley Section has acquired VIP pricing of \$15 per race, which includes a FREE drivers license. Drivers are able to race as many times as they desire, with no minimum or maximum number of races. Guests are welcome to watch from the open space viewing areas, or from within the glass wall private meeting room.

The single seat OTL Storm Karts will fit those in excess of 6'4", and will accommodate those who are able to fit into a typical airline seat (no double seat karts are available, only one person per kart). Once strapped in, you are given the signal to drive onto the track. Once everyone is on the track, it's non-stop fun! After 10-12 minutes of racing, the race is concluded, typically averaging about 14-15 laps (12 laps for Juniors) on a 1/4 mile road course. Afterwards, each driver is provided with a timing sheet, complete with timing of laps for their race (includes all drivers in the race). Speed Raceway is equipped with live-time scoring on large scoreboards for spectators, as well as a large arcade to keep the party going between races.

In order to plan for our group, drivers are requested but not required to register online by September 2nd:

Upon arrival, drivers will pay Speed Raceway for the number of races desired (cash or credit). All drivers are asked to arrive by 10:30AM. Upon conclusion of the racing activities, members and guests may choose to visit local merchants for cool treats, or lunch (not included with registration). A Dairy Queen is located within walking distance, while Lee's Hoagie House (Horsham) and Cafe Lafontana (a white linen restaurant, in Hatboro) are each 3+/- miles away. Driving instructions will be available at the speedway.
